The Technical Packaging Operator role covers intake, conditioning, filtration, cleaning, labelling, filling and packing. The Operator is responsible for ensuring that all beer is processed and packaged to SEB's high standards. A successful Operator will demonstrate the following skills:

- Understand and follow standard operating procedures and cleaning standards, supporting the shift Supervisor and Brewing team

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- Provide day to day support across the entire packaging operation including:
 - In-take, Conditioning and Filtration
 - Filling Duties
 - Labelling and Packaging duties
 - Administration and other duties
 - Identify problems and proactively solve them with the input of the senior team
 - Complete process records accurately, with attention to detail, and processes to SEB requirements;
 - Zero tolerance approach to cleaning and housekeeping
 - Support goods in and goods out processes with direction from the Supervisor, ensuring all documentation is correctly checked and signed for and filed
 - Commit to continual improvement, embracing change and helping the Supervisor to achieve process improvements in the organisation
 - Act as an ambassador for SEB
